

# 6th IEEE Information Assurance Workshop

**The Information Assurance Workshop provides a forum for information assurance researchers, practitioners, and educators to share their research and experience.**

Attendees come from industry, government, and academia. The focus of the workshop is on new and innovative technologies that address one or more of the many challenges faced by Information Assurance practitioners.

Papers will be divided into two broad programs. Approximately 3/4 of the papers will focus on innovative technical research in Information Assurance. The remaining 1/4 of the papers will address recent experience, lessons learned, and best practices from information assurance educators and practitioners.

Last year the IEEE IAW added a new track on **Honeynet Technologies**, sponsored by the Honeynet Project ([www.honeynet.org](http://www.honeynet.org)). This will remain a specific focus of the IAW this year. New this year to the technical track are sessions on **Security Data Visualization** techniques and **Biometrics**.
